Introduction

We trust our suppliers will adopt and implement this Code of Conduct in their operations with us.



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- 1. Suppliers shall conform to related laws and regulations, antitrust practices and conflicts of interest. They will also protect confidentiality and intellectual property. Suppliers must comply with laws and regulations when conducting business, with integrity, transparency, ethics, and accountability. They must avoid corruption, bribery, and inappropriate behavior in all forms. Additionally, they should recognize the importance of respecting others' intellectual property and take care to prevent any violations of these rights.
- 2. Suppliers must comply with labor laws and treat all employees equally and fairly. They must not employ child labor, pregnant women, or migrant workers. Additionally, they must adhere to nondiscrimination policies and the prohibition of forced labor, in accordance with the universal human rights principles upheld by Bumrungrad Hospital.
- 3. Suppliers must comply with occupational health and safety regulations by providing a safe working environment and appropriate personal protective equipment. They must ensure a safe and hygienic work environment and provide safety training to employees.
- 4. Suppliers must comply with environmental management regulations and standards that cover the production, storage, and delivery of products and services. They must use resources efficiently and sustainably, utilize available resources effectively, and choose or produce environmentally friendly products. This includes effective pollution management and waste disposal, as well as reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- 5. Suppliers must support business practices that promote social responsibility, respect local cultures, participate in community and social development, and improve quality of life. They should also encourage community involvement in environmental conservation.
- 6. Supplier must inform stakeholders about the Supplier Code of Conduct and ensure compliance to achieve sustainable procurement processes throughout the supply chain. Partners who violate the Supplier Code of Conduct or engage in actions that may negatively impact Bumrungrad Hospital's operations will be considered for termination of the business relationship.
